**Master plan process:** Summer '06: FBSP members with a list of Pool improvement projects. City manager proposed \$500,000 for capital improvements to Pool in 2007 budget. Fall '06— Council approved budget, passed resolution to write mas ter plan for the Pool, directed planners to work with FBSP and other stakeholders. Council pledged to continue capital invest ments until plan completed. Winter '06— City staff, FBSP, and other stakeholders meet to develop scope of work for master planners. Spring '07— Architects Limbacher & Godfrey hired to write Barton Springs master plan. Architects meet with city staff, FBSP, and other stakeholders to talk about master plan. Architects present scope of work to public hearing, city boards and commissions, other stakeholder groups. Summer '07— Open house and community forum at Barton Springs Pool. Architects prepare for presentation of preliminary report to council. Architects to present to council. Fall '07— Council expected to ap prove 2008 budget with substantial funds for phase one projects from master plan. Winter '07— Staff, FBSP, stakeholders meet to begin implementation of phase one projects. Studies begin for design of phase two projects.
